THE SHOW

You know you're in for a whale of a show when the curtains are drawn to reveal the 12-piece Lou Bronson Orchestra playing some music to get your toes tapping before the performers make their way on stage. This Las Vegas production recreates the Rat Pack's most famous musical numbers and keeps audiences tearing up from laughter at the whimsical onstage ad-libbing. Each tribute artist has nailed down their Rat Pack member's singing, looks, and mannerisms. So when you hear classical songs like "Fly Me To The Moon," "Luck Be A Lady," and "Ain't That A Kick in The Head," you'll have to do a double-take. And just like the original Rat Pack, anyone and everyone can show up during the show. Rat Pack "mascots" like Marilyn Monroe will occasionally stop by and serenade one lucky man with her rendition of "Happy Birthday" in the audience.
